HIPPY supports families for 30 weeks by promoting strong relationships and providing learning materials, books, and curriculum.

AmeriCorps HIPPY home visitors:

- Serve part-time (20-25 hours per week)
- Serve for the 2023-2024 Program Year (August-June)
- Provide service to neighborhoods within the Southern Colorado Region
- Receive a monthly living stipend, mileage
- reimbursement, professional development, and an educational scholarship after the completion of a successful AmeriCorps term.

To apply for an AmeriCorps service term, you must meet the following criteria:

- Have documentation for citizenship, naturalization, or resident status of the United States.
- Be at least 17 years of age (if age 17, must have parent permission)
- Be able to pass all background checks.
- Be able to provide 2 references.
- Able to read, write, and speak in the primary language of families served.
- Available to serve a 900 hours-term from August- June Interested in pursuing further education and professional development.
- Be a person that demonstrates initiative, teamwork, and strong leadership skills.
- Have access to reliable transportation. Be available Monday's from 8:45am-2:30 pm.
